To make the coffee dyed paper I make a mug of coffee and pour it into a rimmed sheet pan.					

To make the coffee dyed paper I make a mug of coffee and pour it into a rimmed sheet pan. I add a mug and a half of cold water to the hot coffee. Dip each sheet into the coffee, making sure each sheet is fully wet. Stack on a wire rack. If possible dry outside in the shade in a single layer. Other wise you can heat your oven up to about 250F. Turn it off. After about 30 minutes put the rack of paper in the oven (turned off) with the oven light on and let dry. This may take 24 hours (depending how much paper you have.) Shuffle the pages in the stack every few hours. Reheat the oven if needed.
